TYPE OF WINE: Red

VINIFICATION: Pre-fermentative maceration to extract aromas and soft tannins. Partially aged in oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

COLOR: Deep garnet.

NOSE: Black fruit aromas and hints of violets, cacao and spices.

PALATE: Rich palate with soft tannins and long finish.

DRINKING TEMPERATURE: Drink at 16°C to 18°C (61°F to 64°F)

FOOD PAIRING: Recommended with rich meat dishes, game and strong cheeses.
