Century old Fiuza is a family estate that developed a modern portfolio of wines, combining indigenous portuguese grapes with international varietals. Our wines embody the essence and tradition of portuguese winemaking at the same time appealing to modern wine lovers.

Fiuza Cabernet Sauvignon belongs to our collection of single varietal wines. Fiuza was pioneer in introducing french grapes in Portugal having some of the oldest vines of this grape variety. This wine is produced to express the best characteristics of this grape in our *terroir*.

Characteristics

APPELLATION: Vinho Regional Tejo

TYPE OF WINE: Red

ALCOHOL CONTENT (VOL.): 13% - 14%

KCAL: 79 KCal/100mL

GRAPE VARIETAL: Cabernet Sauvignon

HARVEST: Early October

TYPE OF SOIL: Clay-Limestone

VINIFICATION: Pré-fermentative maceration to extract aromas and soft tannins.

Aged in French oak barrels for 8 months.

Tasting Notes

COLOR: Deep garnet.

NOSE: Cassis and black cherry aromas with hints of green pepper.

PALATE: Full body, flavor with high tannins and complexity.

DRINKING TEMPERATURE: Drink at 16°C to 18°C (61°F to 64°F)

FOOD PAIRING: Recommended with veal, beef, game, intense cheeses, or complex dishes.
