Characteristics

APPELLATION: DOC do Tejo

TYPE OF WINE: Red

ALCOHOL CONTENT (VOL.): 13% - 14%

KCAL: 80 KCal/100mL

GRAPE VARIETAL: Touriga Nacional and Sousão

HARVEST: Early October

TYPE OF SOIL: Clay-Limestone

VINIFICATION: Pre-fermentative maceration to extract aromas and soft tannins. Partially aged in French oak barrels.

Tasting Notes

COLOR: Deep garnet.

NOSE: Black fruit aromas and hints of violets, cacao and spices.

PALATE: Rich palate with soft tannins and long finish.

DRINKING TEMPERATURE: Drink at 16°C to 18°C (61°F to 64°F)

FOOD PAIRING: Recommended with rich meat dishes, game and strong cheeses.
