DRINKING TEMPERATURE: Drink at 11°C to 13°C (51,84°F to 55,4°F)

FOOD PAIRING: Enjoy as aperitif or with seafood, grilled fish, light pasta, and salad. Also good with rice dishes and goat cheese.
